<p>Help for any Writing Stage</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Prewriting - coming up with a great topic or research idea • Planning - creating an organizational plan for a project • Drafting - guiding students during the drafting process • Revising - answering specific questions about the student's paper 	
<p>Services Offered</p> <p>Face-to-Face Consultations:</p> <p>Consultations are offered on a walk-in or appointment basis. Consultations typically last for half an hour, and in that time we can discuss 2-3 pages of writing, as well as offer suggestions on how students can improve their writing skills and avoid plagiarism, including proper documentation of sources using APA or MLA formatting. Students may also submit papers via email as a Microsoft Word document attachment. Within one working day, the student will receive feedback. The Writing Center advises students seeking guidance with job application materials such as resumes and cover letters.</p>	
<p>Services Offered (Cont.)</p> <p>Writing Workshops:</p> <p>The Writing Center offers many different workshops throughout the fall and spring semesters. These small, scheduled workshops are targeted at specific writing assignments for different classes on campus.</p> <p>Writing Lab:</p> <p>The Writing Center contains 18 computers and areas perfect for study. The Writing Center is also Wi-Fi ready for students who wish to bring laptops.</p> <p>Practice Final Examination for English Composition I Students:</p> <p>Every semester, the Writing Center offers ENGL 1301 students the opportunity to register for a practice final exam and to receive personalized feedback with strategies to improve their final exam essay.</p>
